Message from the Board Chair and Executive Director

The Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia traces its existence back to 1979 with the founding of the Philadelphia Historic Preservation Corporation, established to hold preservation easements on historic buildings in the city. An alliance with the Preservation Coalition in 1996 gave rise to our current organization, now in its 29th year. We are driven by the belief that the preservation, interpretation, and adaptive re-use of our existing buildings acts as a powerful stabilizing force in neighborhoods and communities, while also creating economic opportunity, slowing climate change, and contributing to pride in our city and region.

Philadelphia can be seen as an outdoor museum of 300 years of American architecture, housing the lives and inspiring the dreams of multiple generations of Philadelphians who collectively make this one of the great American cities.

In 2023, we established and strengthened partnerships with people, communities, and historic sites across the region. Whether helping to rescue the historic Henry Ossawa Tanner House in North Philadelphia from demolition, working to restore flood damage to the Marian Anderson Museum, or helping to save an historic prison in Norristown, a Gilded Age mansion in Elkins Park, and an abandoned African American ceremony in the Far Northeast, our emphasis on partnering with people and communities to help them achieve their preservation objectives formed a central role in our work during the course of the year, and will continue in 2024.

In addition to these impactful partnerships, our work on policy advocacy, tours, lectures, seminars, publications, and events continued apace in service of our quest to raise awareness of the value of historic preservation in contemporary life.

We are grateful for your continued support as we carry our momentum into 2024.

Preservation Advocacy

THE ROUNDHOUSE

Published SaveTheRoundhouse.com with support from David Geddes and the DOCOMOMO-Philadelphia Chapter. The site is a gathering place for those interested in the Police Administration Building (aka the Roundhouse), its history, legacy, and efforts to redevelop and preserve this modernist landmark.

PENNSYLVANIA HISTORIC TAX CREDIT


Worked with Preservation Pennsylvania to launch an advocacy campaign that calls for strengthening the Pennsylvania Historic Tax Credit. Kicked off the campaign with a panel discussion in West Chester in October that brought together national experts, state legislators, and local developers.

Organized a seminar on historic preservation and sustainability focusing on the Commercial Property-Assessed Clean Energy (C-PACE) program, a financing tool that allows commercial property owners to borrow money for energy efficiency, water conservation, renewable energy projects, indoor air quality and resiliency projects.

Successfully nominated several properties and one historic object to the Philadelphia Register of Historic Places:



1700-06 Race Street: former James McGinnis Company Building and Arthur Mallie Residence (1700-02) and the former Ellison Apartments (1706).




1131 S. Broad Street: Boot & Saddle neon sign, an excellent example of a "Neon Spectacular" created circa 1955.




5401-03 Vine Street: Home of Crystal Bird Fauset, the first Black female elected state legislator in the U.S.

Promoted preservation priorities throughout the primary and general election cycles by cosponsoring the BUILD Philly Mayoral Forum, meeting with candidates for mayor and city council, and publishing "Preservation Prescriptions for a Prosperous Philadelphia" in AIA Philadelphia's Context magazine.

4949-51 Walnut Street: Paul Robeson House. Co-nominated with the University City Historical Society and West Philadelphia Cultural Alliance.



1621 West Jefferson Street: It Oscar James Cooper residence, founder of Omega Psi Phi.



764-72 South Broad Street: Prettyman Hall / Circle Mission, built 1896 as dwellings and offices, later a hotel and owned by Father Divine's Peace Mission movement since 1940.

Preservation Partnerships

The Preservation Alliance partners with grassroots preservationists and budding organizations to support their efforts in preserving local landmarks, raising awareness of neighborhood histories, and promoting diverse narratives. 2023 saw an expansion in our partnerships with community organizations in support of our strategic initiative to increase neighborhood outreach.



FRIENDS OF THE TANNER HOUSE:

The Alliance serves as fiscal sponsor and advisor which helped the group raise \$360,000 in grants for stabilization, acquisition, and community engagement for the home of artist Henry Ossawa Tanner in Strawberry Mansion.

FRIENDS OF THE AIRY STREET PRISON

Friends of the Airy Street Prison to support the preservation of the former Montgomery County Prison in Norristown, designed in the 1850s by Philadelphia architect Napoleon LeBrun.

MARIAN ANDERSON MUSEUM

Serving as the preservation advisor on restoration work since a devastating flood in 2020.

PHILADELPHIA SOUND PRESERVATION FUND

The Alliance serves as fiscal sponsor for efforts to preserve and redevelop Sigma Sound Studios in Chinatown, where luminaries of American popular music recorded from the 1960s through the '80s.

LYNNEWOOD HALL PRESERVATION FOUNDATION

Serving as advisor to restore and reopen the 110,000 square foot mansion and 34 acres of green space in Elkins Park, vacant since the 1990s.

PHILADELPHIA FUND FOR BLACK SACRED PLACES

A three-year partnership with Partners for Sacred Places - in close collaboration with Black Clergy of Philadelphia and Philadelphia's Black faith community - to expand equitable access to quality public spaces in Philadelphia's neighborhoods and support the efforts of Black congregations to maintain and restore their properties, cultural centers, and neighborhood landmarks for future generations.

ARCHITECTURAL DINNER

The Preservation Alliance's annual Architectural Dinner is held at an architecturally significant location in the Philadelphia region. In 2023, the event took place at the recently redeveloped power plant formerly known as the Delaware Generating Station, now reborn as "The Battery." Tom Caramanico of Independence Historical Trust was honored as the recipient of the 2023 Mary Werner DeNadai Award, presented to a civic leader who has made a lasting impact in historic preservation.




Easement Program



The Preservation Alliance monitors over 250 preservation easements on historic properties in Greater Philadelphia. In 2023, we added the former Aldine Theater at 1826 Chestnut Street (now a CVS) and the historic Ross Watson farmstead in Chester County to our growing portfolio. Easements are an effective tool to ensure the long term preservation of historic structures and sites.

Extant Magazine

The Preservation Alliance's Extant Magazine debuted in Winter 2015. Published three times a year in collaboration with Hidden City Philadelphia, the magazine is distributed free to members and supporters and is available on the Alliance website.



Public Programs

NEIGHBORHOOD WALKING TOURS

Our specialized, in-depth Neighborhood Walking Tours – led by experienced volunteer guides – are offered several times weekly from May through November with each tour focusing on a different part of Greater Philadelphia.

In 2023, our 28 volunteer tour guides led 75 public tours and 25 private tours for over 1200 attendees. New tours in 2023 included Tourison East Mount Airy; Central Bryn Mawr; Lansdowne; Powelton Village; University of Pennsylvania; North Philadelphia; and Frankford. Special tours included the Hassrick House in East Falls, downtown Camden, West Chester, Rose Valley, Third Mint of Philadelphia at Community College, and Mount Moriah Cemetery. A new collaboration tour was created with the Association for Public Art. New collaborations with FringeArts and Mural Arts will be featured in 2024.

SPRING & FALL SPEAKER SERIES

Our Spring and Fall Speaker Series include virtual lectures by local architects, professors, and historians that explore individual neighborhoods that make up Greater Philadelphia and its surrounding areas.

The 2023 Spring Speaker Series featured ten talks that highlighted the theme of the revitalization of historic places. Topics included presentations of Philadelphia's historic streets, the Schuylkill Navigation Canal, Philadelphia's public art, a variety of historic sites, and more.

The Fall Speaker Series profiled eight regional neighborhoods: Frankford, the Byberry African American Burial Ground, Rose Valley, Frankford, Haddonfield, Powelton Village, Baldwin Park, Lansdowne, and Germantown.


